Preschool (2K - 4K)

Girls

- Navy blue long- or short-sleeved HRS polo shirt with any pants or shorts
OR
- HRS navy blue polo dress

Boys

- Navy blue long- or short-sleeved HRS polo shirt with any pants or shorts

Additional Information

- HRS uniform approved sweatshirts are optional
- Tennis shoes are required for all preschool students. No sandals or croc like shoes
- Please send a sweater or jacket for cool weather and a raincoat for rainy days
- Label all items with your child's full name using permanent marker/stickers, including clothing, lunch boxes, backpacks, and other belongings brought to school

Kindergarten – 5th Grade

Girls

Uniform Requirements

- Uniform jumper with light blue Peter Pan collar shirt (long- or short-sleeved)
OR
- Light blue polo
OR
- Light blue HRS turtleneck

Bottoms

- Navy blue pants
- Navy blue shorts or skorts may be worn during Daylight Saving Time
- Kindergarten only may wear jeans, jean shorts, or skorts

Footwear

- 1st – 5th: Black and White or Navy and White Keds saddle oxford shoes
- Kindergarten: Tennis shoes only
- White, black, navy, or HRS crew socks. No ankle socks
- Navy blue or black tights/leggings during winter months

Physical Education

- HRS P.E. t-shirt and shorts
- During winter months, wear HRS sweatshirt and sweatpants over the P.E. uniform
- Tennis shoes with white, black, or navy crew socks on P.E. days
- Kindergarten: P.E. uniform is optional

Grooming & Accessories

- Hair should be clean, neatly groomed, out of the face, and a natural color
- Permitted jewelry:
 - One watch - No smart watches
 - One ring
 - One religious medal worn inside the shirt
 - One pair of stud earrings
- Bracelets and necklaces are not permitted
- Tattoos, body piercings, and writing on the body are not permitted

Boys

Uniform Requirements

- Light blue polo shirt (long- or short-sleeved)
- Optional white undershirt

Bottoms

- Navy blue uniform pants
- Navy blue shorts may be worn during Daylight Saving Time
- Kindergarten only may wear jeans or jean shorts
- Navy blue, brown, or black belt required when pants or shorts have belt loops

Footwear

- 1st – 5th: Light-Brown buck-style shoes
- 1st – 5th: Wallabies, Merrells, Sperrys, and slip-on styles are permitted
- Kindergarten: Tennis shoes only
- White, black, navy, or HRS crew socks. No ankle socks

Physical Education

- HRS P.E. t-shirt and shorts
- During winter months, wear HRS sweatshirt and sweatpants over the P.E. uniform
- Tennis shoes with white, black, or navy crew socks on P.E. days
- Kindergarten: P.E. uniform is optional

Grooming & Accessories

- Hair should be neat, simply styled, not below the eyebrow, the top of the ear or the top of the collar, and the face should be clean-shaven at all times. Sideburns should not be lower than the bottom of the ear
- Permitted jewelry:
 - One watch - No smart watches
 - One ring
 - One religious medal worn inside the shirt
- Earrings, bracelets, and necklaces are not permitted
- Tattoos, body piercings, and writing on the body are not permitted

6th – 8th Grade

Girls

Uniform Requirements

- Uniform skirt (no more than 2 inches above the middle of the knee)
- Light blue untucked blouse (long- or short-sleeved)
- Navy uniform pants
- Fridays Only: Light grey HRS polo

Cold Weather Options

After Daylight Saving Time, students may wear:

- Navy blue HRS sweater
- Navy blue HRS sweater vest
- Navy blue HRS fleece
- Light blue or navy blue HRS sweatshirt
- P.E. sweatshirt

Winter Option

- Navy blue uniform slacks may be worn during winter months only

Footwear

- Black and White or Navy and White saddle oxford shoes
- Light-Brown Sperry boat shoe
- Navy, black, white, or HRS crew socks
- Navy blue or black tights/leggings during winter months

Physical Education

- HRS P.E. uniform
- HRS sweatshirt and sweatpants may be worn over the P.E. uniform during winter
- Tennis shoes with navy, black, white, or HRS crew socks on P.E. days

Grooming & Accessories

- Hair should be clean, neatly groomed, out of the face, and a natural color
- Permitted jewelry:
 - One watch - No smart watches
 - One ring
 - One religious medal worn inside the shirt
 - One pair of small earrings
- Bracelets and necklaces are not permitted
- Makeup is not allowed
- Fingernail polish is not allowed
- Tattoos, body piercings, and writing on the body are not permitted

Boys

Uniform Requirements

- Light blue button-down collared dress shirt
- HRS tie
- Optional white undershirt
- Fridays Only: Light grey HRS polo

Bottoms

- Navy blue uniform pants (shorts are not permitted)
- Black, navy, or brown belt required when pants have belt loops

Cold Weather Options

During winter months, students may wear:

- Navy blue cardigan

- Navy blue V-neck sweater
- Navy blue HRS fleece
- HRS sweatshirt
- P.E. sweatshirt

Footwear

- Light-Brown buck-style shoes with a back
- Wallabies, Merrells, and Sperrys are permitted
- Navy or black crew socks

Physical Education

- HRS P.E. uniform
- HRS sweatshirt and sweatpants may be worn over the P.E. uniform during winter
- Tennis shoes with navy, black, white, or HRS crew socks on P.E. days

Grooming & Accessories

- Hair should be neat, simply styled, not below the eyebrow, the top of the ear or the top of the collar, and the face should be clean-shaven at all times. Sideburns should not be lower than the bottom of the ear
- Permitted jewelry:
 - One watch - No smart watches
 - One ring
 - One religious medal worn inside the shirt

Optional Dress Days

At some time during the year an optional dress code may be permitted. These dress codes are as follows:

Boys

- Any solid color dress trousers (trousers must fit and be worn at the waist)
- Coordinating belt
- Collared dress shirt
- Ties are optional
- Dress Shoes (no backless style foot attire or cowboy boots)
- Mid-Calf Crew socks (no short ankle socks)

Girls

- Properly fitting skirt, slacks or dress (no more than 2 inches above the knee)
- Leggings may be worn with a long shirt that is two inches above the knee
- Blouse or sweater
- Dress shoes (no heels or backless style foot attire or cowboy boots)

Jeans Day Boys and Girls

- Solid color jeans or khaki casual slacks that fit (no oversized pants) worn at the waist
- Coordinating belt
- Shirt or blouse with sleeves
- Solid or striped t-shirts - no inappropriate wording or pictures
- Tennis shoes or uniform shoes
- Crew socks (no short ankle socks)

Tight clothing of any kind is not appropriate for school and should not be worn for any reason

Important Reminders for All Students

Uniform Expectations

- All uniforms should be neat, clean, and in good condition

Label Everything

Please label all items with your child's full name using permanent marker, including:

- Coats
- Jackets
- Sweaters
- Shoes
- Uniform pieces
- Lunch boxes
- Backpacks
- Any other items brought to school

Proper labeling helps ensure lost items are returned quickly
