In life, learning never ends. At least it shouldn't, if we want to continue to improve ourselves in the numerous aspects that make us who we are. To some people, our learning in life ends when we graduate from high school, college, or graduate school. This is why we try to help our students develop a love of learning, so that they will be life long learners. Here at Holy Rosary, we believe in helping our staff to continuously learn how to be a better teacher, how to reach each student, how to prepare their lessons, each unit, and the year; among numerous other topics.

We bring in different speakers throughout the year to help with this continuous learning or professional development. This year alone we have learned (or will learn) more about executive functioning, STEM, lesson planning, data analysis, classroom management, technology integration, and Social/Emotional Learning (SEL). Through coordination with Landon Boone, our staff takes Continuing Education classes for our Catholic faith. Many of our staff have been trained in the Orton Gilingham approach to teaching. While this method is generally used for students with Language Based Learning Differences, the techniques and strategies work for all students. Our Angel staff members are trained as Registered Behavior Technicians (RBTs). This helps them to better serve the students under their care. We also believe in learning from our peers, so we send our teachers out to visit other schools to see what practices those schools use in their classrooms. At our department meetings each month, our teachers share ideas, and effective strategies with each other.

There are more learning opportunities that I am sure I have not mentioned, but this gives you a sample of the many ways we work to be better for your children. Through this learning, our staff strives to be better teachers so that your child can reach their highest potential during their time at Holy Rosary.

P.S. - Holy Rosary also believes in helping parents to continue learning. When we have children, there is not a class we have to take to learn how to be a parent. Therefore, we need to look for resources that will help us raise our children to be the best version of themselves. Throughout the year, Holy Rosary tries to provide opportunities for parents to learn about various topics. Our counselors set up sessions for parents that deal with child development. The Holy Rosary Parent Organization brings in speakers to present on relevant topics for parents. This is done to assist our families with developing good parenting plans for their children.

Let's continue to work together so that we can give our children all they need to be successful in life; including a love for life long learning!


