## BOOK FEE INFORMATION

Welcome to Holy Rosary Parish School's 2023-2024 school year. We are excited to start a new year! Please be sure to check your calendar for important dates that may apply to you. Below are a few dates to remember.

Preview Day will be Monday, August 7, 2023 in the school cafeteria from 9:00 – 12:00. During that time, you can sign up for Parent Organization's activities and room parents, turn in after school care forms, sign up for altar servers, scouts, get information about the Autism Run, pick up your lunch menu and pay on your lunch account. Used uniforms will be available for purchase. After visiting the cafeteria you can go to your child's classroom and meet the teacher. Please bring your school supplies to drop off in your classroom and pick up your carpool sign.

## DRESS CODE

Holy Rosary students are required to wear well-maintained school uniforms at all times. Uniforms are sold through Coles Printing Company. Any questions regarding the uniform policy should be directed to the school administration.

All of your child's belongings should be labeled in permanent ink with his/her full name. This includes coats, jackets, sweaters, shoes, uniforms, lunch boxes, backpacks and anything else that is brought to school.

Extenuating circumstances which prevent a student from wearing the school uniform must be explained in writing by the parent and verified by an administrator before the student reports to class. Any students dressed inappropriately will be asked to call their parent/guardian to bring proper attire for school immediately. The administration reserves the right to send home any student who does not comply with uniform regulations.

### 2, 3 and 4-Year-Old Preschool

Preschool students should wear a navy-blue logo uniform shirt with any shorts, pants, skirts or skorts. A navy-blue polo dress is available for girls which is to be worn during the warm months. Tennis shoes are preferred – no flip flops or backless footwear. Please ensure that your child has a sweater or jacket for cool weather and a raincoat for rainy days. Please label everything.

### Kindergarten

Kindergarten boys and girls should wear the light blue Holy Rosary polo style shirts with navy blue or jean shorts in the summer or navy-blue pants or jeans in the winter. White or navy-blue crew socks and tennis shoes should be worn. No boots, cleats, roller skate shoes or sandals. Please ensure that your child has a sweater or jacket during cool weather. If you choose to wear the jumper, only navy blue or black tights may be worn with the jumper in the winter.

### Regulations for Boys Uniforms

- ◆ Navy blue uniform pants - grades 1-8.
- ◆ Light blue HR polo style shirt, long or short sleeve - grades K-5.
- ◆ Light blue button down collared shirt, long or short sleeve(no emblems, logos, or designs) - grades 6-8
- ◆ Undershirts are optional but they must be solid white - grades 1-8
- ◆ Navy blue cardigan or v-neck sweater - no logos, designs, or emblems(optional) - grades 1-8
- ◆ Grades K-8 - Navy blue fleece jackets, or the Holy Rosary P.E. sweatshirt may be worn. These are the only items allowed to be worn in a classroom and only when winter uniforms are worn.
- ◆ Navy blue, brown or black belt - grades 1-8 (If pants have belt loops, a belt must be worn)
- ◆ Navy blue or black mid-calf crew socks must be worn - grades 1-8 \*\*\***No short ankle socks**\*\*\*
- ◆ Light colored buck style shoes, Wallabees, Merrill's or Sperry's – slip on style may be worn.
- ◆ Navy striped tie - grades 6-8 purchased through Cole's.
- ◆ Holy Rosary P.E. uniform - grades 1-8. Sweatshirts and sweat pants are required during winter after daylight savings time changes and must be worn over the P.E. shorts and shirt.
- ◆ P.E. uniforms must be well maintained - no cut off edges, elastic removed or writing. P.E. uniforms may be worn in the classroom on P.E. day. White, black or navy blue mid-calf socks must be worn with tennis shoes.
- ◆ Hair - clean, neatly combed, natural color, above the collar and ears. No rattails, Mohawks or shaved designs.
- ◆ Jewelry - one watch, one ring, one religious medal worn inside shirt. No earrings, bracelets or necklaces.
- ◆ **Tattoos, body piercings or writing on bodies or clothing will not be permitted.**

## Regulations for Girls Uniforms

- ◆ Uniform Jumper (no more than 2 inches above middle of the knee) - grades 1-5. Optional for Kindergarten.
- ◆ Uniform skirt (no more than 2 inches above the middle of the knee) - grades 6-8.
- ◆ **No rolling of the skirt waistband is allowed.**
- ◆ Light blue blouse, long or short sleeve (Peter Pan collar) grades 1-5.
- ◆ Light blue blouse, long or short sleeve for grades 6-8
- ◆ Grades 6-8 - Navy blue sweater or sweater vest, navy blue fleece jacket, light blue HRS sweatshirt or HR P.E. sweatshirt - Required after daylight savings time.
- ◆ Navy blue long uniform pants - (no emblems or designs) winter months only - **navy blue sweater or HR sweatshirt must be worn with pants** - grades 1-8
- ◆ Grades 1-5 - Navy blue fleece jacket, HR P.E. sweatshirt, Light blue HRS sweatshirt, navy blue cardigan or V-neck sweater (optional). These are the only items allowed to be worn in a classroom and only when winter uniforms are worn.
- ◆ Black and white saddle oxfords - grades 1-8 (grades 1-4 may wear the saddle oxford style Keds).
- ◆ White crew socks - **no short ankle socks!!!**
- ◆ Navy blue or black tights (cold weather) - grades K-8. No leggings.
- ◆ Light blue logo turtleneck (optional) - grades 1-5.
- ◆ Holy Rosary P.E. uniform - grades 1-8. Sweatshirts and sweat pants are required during winter after daylight savings time changes and must be worn over the P.E. shorts and shirt. P.E. uniforms must be well maintained - no cut off edges, elastic removed or writing. P.E. uniforms may be worn in the classroom on P.E. day. White, black, or navy blue mid-calf socks must be worn with tennis shoes.
- ◆ HAIR - clean, combed, simply styled and natural color. No dyeing hair a different color than your natural color. No feathers or beads allowed in hair.
- ◆ **No makeup is allowed!!!**

- ◆ Jewelry - one watch, one ring, one pair of stud earrings in the earlobe only, religious medal (worn under blouse)

- ◆ **No fingernail polish.**

- ◆ **Tattoos, body piercings or writing on bodies or clothing will not be permitted.**

## Optional Fall/Spring Uniform

During daylight savings time, students in grades 1-5 have the option of wearing navy blue uniform walking shorts which may be purchased from Cole's and are to be worn with the HRS polo shirt. Girls in grades 1-5 also have the option of wearing a navy blue skort. White or navy-blue mid calf crew socks must be worn with the shorts or skort. **(No short socks!)**

## **2023-2024 AFTER SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM**

**AFTER SCHOOL CARE BEGINS AT 3:15 P.M. ON REGULAR SCHOOL DAYS AND 2:45 ON 2:30 DAYS (TUESDAYS). CHILDREN MAY NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED AFTER THESE TIMES ON THE CORNER, IN THE GYM, AROUND THE STATUE OF MARY OR WAITING FOR AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES (THIS INCLUDES SPORTS, CHEERLEADING, SCOUTS, ETC.). COACHES WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN OUT CHILDREN FOR PRACTICES. CHILDREN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE AFTER SCHOOL CARE ON THEIR OWN.**

**THE FEES FOR 3:15 TO 4:00 AND 2:45 TO 4:00, WILL BE \$5.00 PER DAY. AFTER 4:00 P.M. REGULAR DAYCARE FEES WILL APPLY.**

REGISTRATION FEES: A \$25.00 non-refundable registration fee payable to Holy Rosary School will maintain placement for your child for the school year. A \$40.00 registration fee will be charged for family enrollment.

### **AFTER SCHOOL CARE FEES FOR FULL TIME/PREPAID CHILDREN**

\$60.00 PER WEEK PER CHILD

\$100.00 PER WEEK FOR TWO OR MORE

\$12.00 PER DAY FOR WEEKS INCLUDING A HOLIDAY OR HALF DAY.

**FULL TIME ENROLLMENT REQUIRES PAYMENT WHETHER IN ATTENDANCE OR NOT. ONE WEEK WILL BE ALLOWED FOR VACATION DURING THE 40 WEEK SCHOOL YEAR. YOU MAY SPLIT THIS UP ANYWAY YOU CHOOSE. FEES ARE TO BE PAID THE MONDAY OF THE WEEK YOU ARE SCHEDULED TO STAY IN AFTER SCHOOL CARE.**

### **AFTER SCHOOL CARE FEES/PART-TIME - PAYABLE ON FRIDAY AFTER THE DAYS YOU STAY**

\$15.00 PER DAY PER CHILD

\$25.00 PER DAY TWO OR MORE

SNACK/SIGN OUT: A snack and drink is included in the ASC fee. When picking up your child, a signature along with the time picked up is required. If your child has been put on the roll and you do not sign them out, we assume they are here until 6:00 p.m. and you will be charged accordingly.

PICK-UP: Children must be picked up no later than 6:00 p.m. each evening. If for some reason you are going to be delayed, please inform us by calling on the school phone, 685-1231. Please be considerate in picking your child up on time, as we also have evening obligations to meet. The fee for late pick-up will be \$1.00 per minute after 6:00 p.m.

DISCIPLINE: All children enrolled in after school care will be expected to follow rules established by the staff for the safety and smoothness of the program. Children with continual behavior problems will be asked to leave the program.

**ALL PAYMENTS ARE DUE WEEKLY. ACCOUNTS CAN BE VIEWED ON RENWEB, THROUGH THE PARENTS WEB. PAYMENTS CAN BE MADE ONLINE, OR THROUGH KIDMAIL OR IN THE OFFICE.**
