

Mr. Mullis' Letter

September 18, 2024

At this point, we are more than half way through our first nine weeks of school. The students and teachers are settling into the year and hitting their stride in their classes. A lot of the newness is wearing off as well. The students have a better understanding of what their teacher expects throughout the day. They have developed new friendships and strengthened current ones. Students have also created their routines for getting their work down; both at school and at home. All of these things are quality lessons to learn and build upon as they continue through the year.

With this "settling in", it can also bring about some poor decisions because the students are now comfortable with each other and their teachers. The important lessons we learn in life are not learned with just one instance. We learn those lessons because we are taught about it multiple times. We hear what the appropriate decisions or choices would be and then how to implement those decisions and choices. This year we have emphasized the need to continue reviewing our expectations and rules throughout the year. It should not be taught once at the beginning of the year, and then never addressed again.

We ask that you help us with the learning of this lesson. You can do this in First, please continue to review with your child periodically the two wavs. expectations that I emailed to you a few weeks ago. This will help them to understand them more quickly. Second, help them grow in their ability to learn about rules by discussing your house rules with them. The more they realize that there are rules in all aspects of our lives that we need to follow, the better off they will be. Whether it is at home, at school, on the athletic field, driving, or in general society, there are always rules to follow. The earlier we teach our children about rules and the expectation that the rules should be followed, the easier their life (and yours) will be as they grow up. Children want structure and boundaries despite what they might say, and, yes, this includes junior high students. It brings them stability, comfort, and a feeling that they are safe because they know what is expected. When children are not given any direction about this, they are basically rudderless. They will aimlessly float through life because they do not have the map to follow.

Give your child the map and the skills to read it. This is one of the greatest gifts you can give them. If they know how to utilize this gift, it will give them order and stability throughout their life. Thank you for working with us on this important matter.

Pick-up:

- When you arrive to pick up your child each day we ask that you call the Aftercare number and let the staff know you are here. They will instruct you as to where they will meet you with your child.
- The Aftercare number is 901-724-5781. Please put this number in your phone.
- If you get to school and do not have the number it is posted on the main door and the red awning door for your convenience.
- Parents are responsible to clock their child out each day. The Aftercare staff will have an iPad for you to clock out with.
- You will need your personal FACTS ID number to clock out. If you do not know your ID number you can find it in your Family Portal account on the Family page. Also, the Aftercare staff can help you with your number if needed.
- Any child that is not clocked out will be given a clock out time of 6:00pm. Please be sure to clock your child out before you leave.
- If someone other than you will be picking up your child please notify the school beforehand. You may email your teacher or Ms. Bryan, call the school office, or call Ms. Bryan on the aftercare phone once Aftercare has started. Let them know the name of the person who is picking up and be sure to give that person your ID number to clock out your child(ren).
